## By the glass

**GRAYSON CELLARS CABERNET SAUVIGNON, UNITED STATES \$11 6oz GLASS | \$16 9oz GLASS | \$44 BOTTLE**

We think we have found a great value red wine from California in a time when that's easier said than done. This wine is built with good structure, black current fruits, and a slightly spice finish.

**DOMAINE LAFOND COTES DU RHONE, FRANCE \$10 6oz GLASS | \$15 9oz GLASS | \$40 BOTTLE**

Plush and dangerously easy to drink, dark plum and blackberry flavours with a slight earthiness on the finish.

**SUR ANDES MALBEC, ARGENTINA \$8.5 6oz GLASS | \$12.75 9oz GLASS | \$34 BOTTLE**

Rich dark fruit aromas are elevated by a lifted floral quality that suggests violets. Smooth and fruity with a lovely dry finish, this is an easy-drinking crowd pleaser.

**SAN FELO 'BALLA LA VECCHIA', ITALY \$10 6oz GLASS | \$15 9oz GLASS | \$40 BOTTLE**

A soft and silky red from Tuscany. A blend of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, this is a great blend of 'Old World' and 'New World' wine styles.

**BLUE MOUNTAIN PINOT NOIR, CANADA \$60**

This highly sought-after pinot noir from one of Canada's best producers is not to be missed. There is an old world feel to this wine without sacrificing the vibrant ripeness that one expects from pinot noir. Bright cherry and raspberry fruit with a spicy finish and refreshing acidity.

**HEARTLAND SHIRAZ, AUSTRALIA \$40**

From one of Australia's best winemakers, Ben Glaetzer, this shiraz will make you ask yourself why you stopped drinking Aussie shiraz. Welcome back!

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## By the glass

**VAL D'OCA PROSECCO, ITALY \$11 6oz GLASS | \$44 BOTTLE**

Ripe apricot and nectarine aromas and flavours with very persistent and soft bubble. An excellent way to start a meal!

**TEDESCHI PINOT GRIGIO, ITALY \$10 6oz GLASS | \$15 9oz GLASS | \$40 BOTTLE**

Layers of stone fruit, nicely textured on the palette with well balanced acidity leading into a smooth & lush finish.

**LEITZ 'EINS ZWEI DRY' RIESLING, GERMANY \$11 6oz GLASS | \$16 9oz GLASS | \$44 BOTTLE**

A dry version of one of the most iconic white grapes, with lots of minerality, apple and pear notes.

**VINA MAYU SAUVIGNON BLANC, CHILE \$8.5 6oz GLASS | \$12.75 9oz GLASS | \$34 BOTTLE**

From the northern Chile in the Elqui Valley where annually they see less than 80mm of rainfall per year, optimum for growing high quality grapes. Try this wine and we think you'll agree.

## Bottles

**OPPIDUM CHARDONNAY, FRANCE \$40**

Just a touch of oak influence to provide a bit of spice and body to the wine with all the classic flavours you'd expect.

**MICHEL GASSIER VIOGNIER, FRANCE \$44**

Very aromatic and expressive wine with mango, nectarine with a refreshingly crisp and full mouthfeel.
